

ORDINANCE NO. 1391

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 4.16 OF THE EUREKA SPRINGS MUNICIPAL CODE COVERING OCCUPATIONAL LICENSES FOR BUSINESS FIRMS AND INDIVIDUALS OPERATING WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS; AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1025; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY TO EXIST

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 1025 was duly passed and approved by the City Council of Eureka Springs, Arkansas on the 12th day of November, 1977, and subsequently published in accordance with the law; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has found that certain occupational licenses were omitted or are inequitable under Ordinance #1295, the former amendment to Ordinance No. 1025;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, that Ordinance No. 1025 is hereby amended as follows, to-wit:

Section 1. Chapter 4.16 OCCUPATION LICENSES, Sections 4.16.01 and 4.16.03 of the Eureka Springs Municipal Code, are hereby amended with the following insertions:

4.16.01 Procurement of license, required. (addition to paragraph)

Fees for new licenses starting September 1 through November 30 for each year will be pro-rated on a monthly basis. In the advent of a December opening, the fee will be forgiven and the permit issued for this single month at no charge.

Section 2.

A. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

B. If any provision, word, phrase, sentence, paragraph or section of this Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall be deemed to apply only to such provision, word, phrase, sentence, paragraph or section, and the remainder of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. Emergency.

It has been found and is hereby declared, that the passing of this Ordinance is necessary for the preservation of health, safety and welfare


of the residents and property owners of the city, and an emergency is hereby declared to exist and is so declared, whereby this Ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
