

ORDINANCE #1397

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 2, CHAPTER 2.36, OF THE EUREKA SPRINGS MUNICIPAL CODE, EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 1991, COVERING OFFICE OF CITY ATTORNEY

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, to amend Title 2, Chapter 2.36, Section 2.36.05, of its municipal code to update salary and fees applicable to the office of City Attorney,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS:

Section 1:

Section 2.36.05, of Chapter 2.36, Title 2, is hereby amended to read as follows:

2.36.05 Salary and Fees:

The City Attorney shall receive, as salary, the gross sum of Three Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$300.00) each month, payable in regular monthly installments on the last day of the month. In the event that the City Attorney renders official legal services during any month wherein the same requires more than six (6) hours during any such month, the City Attorney shall be entitled to receive additional compensation for such services rendered at the rate of Sixty and No/100 Dollars (\$60.00) per hour of professional services rendered. With respect to this paragraph, fractions of an hour shall be strictly treated as being directly proportionate to the amount of additional fees to which the City Attorney shall be entitled. The City Attorney shall prepare a monthly itemized statement for such additional fees, and shall submit the same to the Office of the City Clerk/Treasurer not later than the 5th day of the month immediately following the month in which such additional fees were earned by the City Attorney, provided that where such additional fees were earned by rendering services to the City Advertising and Promotion Commission or the City Cemetery Commission, the City Attorney shall submit his statement for the proper portion of such fees directly to the appropriate Commission, as aforesaid. This Paragraph applies only to the duties of the City Attorney provided in Section 4.

Section 2. The provisions of this Ordinance are severable, and if a section, phrase or provision shall be declared invalid, such declaration shall not effect the validity of the remainder of the Ordinance.


Section 3. All Ordinances and Resolutions and parts thereof, in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 4. This Ordinance will become effective January 1, 1991, to apply to a duly elected City Attorney for the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas.
