ORDINANCE 1402

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING COMPENSATION FOR CITY COUNCIL MEMBERS

WHEREAS, the acceptance of responsibility as a council member is entered into in spite of personal sacrifice, demands on time and lost earning ability; and

WHEREAS, in order to allow any person who is a qualified elector of our community to be capable of serving as a council member aside from financial constraints is in keeping with our form of government;

NOW, THEREFORE, the council term of office, beginning January 1, 1990, will be compensated in this manner:

For each regularly scheduled council meeting, each council member will be compensated \$100, provided that the council member is present at the roll call and stays through the meeting until its adjournment.

For each special called council meeting, the same compensation as for a regular council meeting shall be paid, under the same conditions.

For committee meetings, public hearings, public meetings and other such meetings of committees or commissions, etc., no compensation shall be paid.

Any other compensation is not implied or authorized by this ordinance.
