

ORDINANCE 1411

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 8.16.06
OF THE EUREKA SPRINGS MUNICIPAL CODE

WHEREAS, it has been recommended that a loading zone be established on Spring Street adjacent to the Palace Hotel and existing businesses for the following reasons: to provide a safe place for the Eureka Springs trolley to pickup and discharge passengers and a place where businesses, service vehicles and visitors can load and unload.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas:

Section 1: That Chapter 8.16.06 of the Eureka Springs Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding Sub-paragraph 17 thereto:



~~17~~. That a loading and unloading zone is hereby established on Spring Street in front of the building located at 135 Spring Street, starting at the south corner thereof and extending 92.8 feet north to the doorway at 137 Spring Street.

Section 2: All Ordinances and Resolutions and parts thereof, in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.


