

ORDINANCE NO. 1416

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING THE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS FOR PURCHASE OF A CARDIAC MONITOR/DEFIBRILATOR FOR EMERGENCY SERVICES DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY TO EXIST

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. Bidding Requirements Waived.

Pursuant to Section 3.04.03, Eureka Springs Municipal Code, the bidding requirements for the purchase of a LP 10 Monitor/Defibrillator are hereby waived. The bidding requirements are not deemed feasible or practical because of the uniform cost of this item from suppliers, and stock availability from proposed source.

Section 2. Contract Authorized.

The Mayor and Clerk/Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to contract with Physico Control, Memphis, TN for the delivery of one LP 10 Monitor/Defibrillator/Pacer with battery support system, auxiliary power supply and carrying case at the total cost of \$9,900.00 plus taxes and shipping charges.

Section 3. Emergency Declared.

The City Council of the City of Eureka Springs finds an emergency exists because as required by Arkansas State law for Paramedic level EMS service, it is necessary to carry a cardiac monitor/defibrillator on each ambulance. Because of age of existing units carried on the two ambulances operated by the system, breakdowns have occurred; and one existing unit is, at present, being repaired.


Because it is felt that purchasing new equipment immediately is necessary for the welfare of the community, and because this supplier is the only source with stock availability at the current market price, a state of emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its approval and passage.
