

ORDINANCE NO. 1424

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING THE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS FOR PURCHASING A VEHICLE FOR THE EUREKA SPRINGS POLICE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY TO EXIST

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. Bidding Requirements Waived.

Pursuant to Section 3.04.03, Eureka Springs Municipal Code, the bidding requirements are hereby waived for the purchase of a reconditioned, equipped police patrol vehicle for a price not to exceed \$8,000 plus tax and licensing fees.

Section 2. Contract Authorized.

The Mayor and Clerk/Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to contract with Diversifleet, Inc. of Kansas City, KS for the delivery of a reconditioned, low mileage police patrol vehicle. The Police Chief is authorized to negotiate for make, model, year and appropriate equipment.

Section 3. Emergency Declared.

The City Council of the City of Eureka Springs finds that no other apparent provider is available to offer this equipment at this savings. The vehicle is to replace former equipment totally damaged in an accident caused through no fault of the department, and it is felt the purchasing of this vehicle is necessary for the welfare of the community. Therefore, a state of emergency is deemed to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its publication.
