

ORDINANCE #1435

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING THE BIDDING ON REHABILITATION OF FORTY-THREE MANHOLES WITHIN THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY TO EXIST

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. Bidding Requirements Waived:

Pursuant to Section 3.04.03, Eureka Springs Municipal Code, the bidding requirements are hereby waived for labor and the purchase of materials necessary to rehabilitate forty-three (43) manholes within the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas for a cost not to exceed \$23,499.20.

Section 2. Contract Authorized:

The Mayor and Clerk/Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to contract with Bonds-Long, Inc. of Clinton, Arkansas for the materials, labor and equipment necessary to rehabilitate these forty-three manholes with an average depth of 4.79', at a cost of \$93.20 per vertical foot and \$100 per invert.

Section 3. Emergency Declared:


The City Council of the City of Eureka Springs finds that no other apparent provider is available to offer this material in this area at this cost, and it is felt the rehabilitation of these manholes is necessary for the welfare and health of the community. Therefore, a state of emergency is deemed to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and publication.
