

ORDINANCE NO. 1479(Amended)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 8.16.06-2 OF THE
EUREKA SPRINGS MUNICIPAL CODE ESTABLISHING LOADING
AND NO PARKING ZONES IN THE CITY OF EUREKA
SPRINGS, ARKANSAS

WHEREAS, it has been determined that for proper traffic control in the city certain areas should be designated as loading or no parking zones:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS, THAT:

Section 1. That Extra Provisions, subsection of Section 8.16.06-2 of the Eureka Springs Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding the following:

28. The current loading zone by the Basin Park Hotel at 12 Spring of fifty one feet (51') is extended to include one parking space to the north (51' + 18'9"= 69'9").

29. The current loading zone at 40 Spring of thirty one feet (31') is extended to include one parking space to the north (31' +18' = 49').

30. The current Handicapped parking space at 54 Spring be moved to the first parking space on the south side of Pendergrass Corner (flat area at 58 Spring).

31. A new loading zone be created at 82-84 Spring by eliminating two parking spaces (38'6") which connect with the no-parking/hydrant in front of 80 Spring.

32. An off-street loading zone sixteen feet (16') wide be created at the intersection of Tulip and Spring Streets.

33. An eighteen foot (18') loading zone be created at the north corner of Linwood.

34. A new curb will be constructed on west side of Linwood toward Prospect and designated a no-parking zone extending to the intersection of Fairmount. An eighteen foot (18') yellow loading zone will be created on the west side of Prospect St. directly in front of St. James' Episcopal Church. A limited no-parking zone will be created on the west side of Prospect beginning in front of 24 Prospect and proceeding forty-four feet (44') in length to the south to the driveway near intersection of Howell St.

35. No parking will be allowed on the west side of Washington St. extending thirty-three feet, six inches (33'6") from the corner of Summit St. to in front of 2 Washington.

36. No parking will be allowed between 9:00 a.m and 6:00 p.m. on the east side of Spring Street extending forty-five feet (45') in front of 265 Spring, with limited parking during other hours.

Section 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. It is hereby found by the City Council of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, that establishment of these regulations is essential for the preservation of safety and general welfare of the citizens of the city; and an emergency is hereby declared to exist. Therefore, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from the date of its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
