

ORDINANCE #1486(AMENDED)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 8.16.06-02 OF THE EUREKA SPRINGS MUNICIPAL CODE ESTABLISHING PARKING ZONES IN THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY TO EXIST

WHEREAS, it has been determined that for proper traffic control in the city certain areas should be designated with limited parking signage:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS, THAT:

Section 1. That Extra Provisions, subsection of Section 8.16.06-2 of the Eureka Springs Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding the following:

38. Six spaces on the west side of Spring St. in the vicinity of the Carnegie Library and Crescent Spring, be marked with the following signage:

Two spaces to be white curbed stating Library Parking only  
Signage on these spaces and additional four spaces shall state:  
"Limited One Hour Parking, 11:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., 7 days a week"

39. Five spaces on east side of Spring St. in Blk. 21 across from the intersection of Tulip St., be marked with the following signage:

"Limited One Hour Parking, 11:00 a.m to 5:00 p.m., 7 days a week"

40. No parking will be allowed on 185-1/2 ft. of Armstrong St. in Block 155, behind the Downtown Trolley Depot and the parking lot on the south side of the Court House.

Section 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. It is hereby found by the City Council of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, that establishment of these regulations is essential for the preservation of safety and general welfare of the citizens of the city because current parking hinders the flow of traffic on Spring and Armstrong Streets; and an emergency is hereby declared to exist. Therefore, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from the date of its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
