

ORDINANCE NO. 1489

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 9.16 OF THE EUREKA SPRINGS  
MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING THE NUMBERING OF CITY STRUCTURES

WHEREAS, it has been found that Ordinance #1432(Amended), passed on July 10, 1991, contained incorrect information regarding proper assignment of street address numbers for structures in the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS:

Section 1: That Title 9, Chapter 9.16, Section 9.16.01 of the Municipal Code of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, be amended to read as follows:

9.16.01 All buildings, including commercial, residential or multi-family, shall have no less than three (3") inch street address numbers posted on the front entrance of each building. The street address number for each building will be the present number assigned to it; and if no street address number has been assigned to the building, the Fire Official shall assign a number. Numbers are to be a contrasting color from the background.

Section 2.: Due to the necessity of locating structures in the city due to day-to-day or unusual reasons, the City Council finds that to protect the safety and welfare of its citizens an emergency exists, and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from the date of its passage, approval and publication according to law.
