

ORDINANCE NO. 1502

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 8.16 OF THE EUREKA SPRINGS MUNICIPAL CODE ESTABLISHING PARKING REGULATIONS FOR THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY TO EXIST

WHEREAS, it has been determined that additional parking spaces for the disabled should be made available to the public;

Section One

Chapter 8.16, "Parking," Eureka Springs Municipal Code, is hereby amended by the addition of the following paragraphs to Section 8.16.06-2, Extra Provisions:

41. Two parking spaces, located on the South side of Mountain Street parallel to the First Baptist Church at 30 Mountain Street and just above the intersection of Spring and Mountain Streets, will be designated by signage as "Handicapped Parking, 9:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m., Sunday Only."

42. Three parking spaces, located in front of the First Presbyterian Church at 209 Spring Street, will be designated by signage as "Handicapped Parking, 8:00 a.m. to Noon, Sunday Only."

Section Two


All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section Three

It is hereby found by the City Council of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, that disabled residents of the City require additional reserved parking spaces as described in the parking provisions presented above and that the establishment of these parking provisions is essential for the preservation of the safety and general welfare of the citizens of the City. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from the date of its passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
