

ORDINANCE #1507

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING THE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS FOR ENGAGING FIRMS TO REPAIR STREET, SIDEWALK, WALL AND HANDRAIL ON PORTION OF SPRING STREET

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. Bidding Requirements Waived:

Pursuant to the provision of Section 3.04.03 of the Eureka Springs Municipal Code, the bidding requirements for the provision of engaging a firm to repair the street, sidewalk, wall and handrail beginning at the intersection of Spring and Main Streets, are hereby waived because the grave danger of injury at the location and the necessity for immediate repair make the bidding process neither feasible or practical.

Section 2. Contract Authorized:

The Public Works Director is hereby authorized and directed to engage the necessary expertise and manpower to safely repair this caved-in area, and the City Council approves expenditure of this repair in an amount not to exceed \$24,000.

Section 3. Emergency Declared:

The City Council finds that the immediate passage of this ordinance is necessary to preserve the public health and safety of the citizens and visitors of Eureka Springs, Arkansas. Therefore, this ordinance shall be effective from and after its passage according to law.
