

ORDINANCE NO. 1525

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND ELIMINATING AREAS FOR
LOADING , PARKING, NO PARKING AND TROLLEY ZONES
ON SPRING STREET

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Eureka Springs has determined that the orderly flow of traffic in downtown Eureka Springs requires that the parking on Spring Street should be modified, as set out below:

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas:

Section 1: That Sub-paragraph 28 of Chapter 8.16.06-2 of the Eureka Springs Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

28. That the current loading zone by the Basin Park Hotel at 12 Spring Street, currently 69'9", is extended to include three additional parking spaces to the north.

Sectional 2. That Sub-paragraph 31 of Chapter 8.16.06-2 of the Eureka Springs Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

31. The loading zone at 82-84 Spring Street which connects with the no-parking/hydrant shall be eliminated and that area shall be a no parking zone.

Section 3: That Chapter 8.16.06-2 of the Municipal Code is amended by the addition of a new Sub-Paragraph, 43, thereto:

43. A trolley stop zone is created on the east side of Spring Street beginning at 81 Spring Street and running south 60 feet.

Section 4: That Sub-Paragraph 29 of Chapter 8.16.06-2 of the Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

29. The current loading zone at 40 Spring Street, consisting of two spaces, is hereby eliminated and parking established thereon.

Section 5: The Chapter 8.16.06-2 of the Municipal Code is amended by the addition of a new Sub-Paragraph, 44, thereto:

44 That the following zones are established on Spring Street, beginning 25 feet north of the walkway leading to the Basin Spring Building and running south to the junction of Spring and Main:

- a. A handicap parking space beginning 25 feet north of the walkway and running south 25 feet;
- b. then a 9-foot handicap ramp;


- c. then a 50 foot loading zone;
- d. then a 55 feet trolley stop; and
- e. the remainder a no-parking zone.

Section 6: All Ordinances or Resolutions and parts thereof, in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 7: Inasmuch and the smooth and orderly flow of traffic on Spring Street is of paramount importance to the City, it is hereby found that an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from the date of its passage, approval and publication according to law.





