

ORDINANCE NO. 1531

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 1515 AND  
SPECIFYING WHERE EXPENDITURES CAN BE MADE

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it would be in its best interest to repeal Ordinance No. 1515, and provide in a new ordinance monies to be used by the Parking Authority to develop the parking area on Planer Hill and to develop a master plan for the City for parking.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 1515 is repealed in its entirety.


Section 2. That the Eureka Springs fiscal budget be amended to reflect a \$15,000 advancement to be made to the Eureka Springs Parking Authority and that said monies shall be used only for the project on Planer Hill (Bass Property) and to develop a master plan for parking in the City.

Section 3. That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of such conflict.


Section 4. That because parking is of paramount concern to the citizens of Eureka Springs and the tourist season has begun, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force from the date of its passage, approval and publication according to law.
