

ORDINANCE NO. 1570

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 8.16, PARKING, SECTION 8.16.06-2, PROVISIONS, AND CHAPTER 8.20, PARKING METERS, SECTION 8.20.05, PARKING METER ZONES, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE AND ESTABLISHING AND ELIMINATING PARKING, NO-PARKING, LOADING, AND TROLLEY-STOP ZONES

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Eureka Springs has determined that parking, no-parking, loading, and trolley-stop zones should be modified in order to facilitate orderly traffic flow in downtown Eureka Springs;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS, THAT:

Section One: Paragraphs To Be Deleted From Section 8.16.02

a. The following paragraphs shall be deleted from Section 8.16.06-2, Extra Provisions: Paragraphs 1, 24, 28, 30, and 43.

Section Two: Paragraphs Of Section 8.16.02 To Be Amended

a. Paragraph 26 shall read: A loading and unloading zone is established on the west side of Spring Street starting at the north corner of the building at 18 Spring Street (Basin Park Hotel Area) and extending 124' north.

b. Paragraph 29 shall read: The current loading zone in front of 40 - 44 Spring (connecting with the fire hydrant no-parking zone to the south) is extended to the north for a total distance of 37'.

c. Paragraph 44 shall read: The following zones are established on Spring Street beginning at the intersection of Spring and Main Streets and extending north:

1. A no-parking zone extending 29' north from said intersection;
2. Then, a loading zone extending 76' north;
3. Then, a no-parking zone extending 47.5' north;
4. Then, a handicap access curb and walkway (in front of the Basin Spring Bathhouse Bridge) extending 18.5' north; and
5. Then, a handicap parking space extending 20' north.

Section Three: Paragraphs to be Added To Section 8.16.02

a. Paragraph 45. A trolley stop is established on the west side of Spring Street in front of Basin Spring Park. Beginning at the southern park entrance steps, 12' of the current no-parking zone will remain; and then, a 72' trolley stop will extend to the north. The remainder of the current no-parking zone (from the newly created trolley stop to the Basin Park Hotel) will remain.

b. Paragraph 46. The following zones are established along Spring Street.

1. A trolley stop is established on the west side of Spring Street in front of 52 Spring (immediately to the south of the existing Pendergrass Corner fire hydrant no-parking zone) and extending 45' south; and,

2. Then, a handicap parking space extending 20' south.

c. Paragraph 47. A loading zone is established beginning at the corner no-parking zone on the south side of the intersection of Mountain and Spring Streets and extending 66' south.

d. Paragraph 48. A trolley stop is established on the west side of Spring Street beginning near the western boundary of Sweet Spring Park and extending 42' south.

e. Paragraph 49. A no-parking zone is established between the west side of Flint Street and the east side of Water Street.

Section Four: Amendment to Section 8.20.05

a. The following paragraph shall be added to Chapter 8.20, Parking Meters, Section 8.20.05, Parking Meter Zones:

Three parking meters will be installed on the south side of Flint Street facing Water Street, to the east of The Little Chapel.

Section Five: Repeal Clause


All Ordinances or Resolutions, and parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section Six: Emergency Clause

The City Council of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, hereby determines and declares that an emergency exists by reason of the necessity of implementing on March 1, 1994, the Ellis Grade and Spring Street one-way traffic plan for large vehicles and regulating parking, no-parking, loading, and trolley stop zones. The immediate effect of the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and visitors of the City. This Ordinance, therefore, shall be in full force and effect as of the date of its adoption.
