

ORDINANCE NO. 1582

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CALLING AND HOLDING OF A SPECIAL ELECTION TO GAIN PUBLIC OPINION ON THE ISSUE OF WHETHER OR NOT PARKING METERS SHOULD BE REMOVED FROM A PORTION OF SPRING STREET AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the question has arisen of whether or not parking meters should be removed from that portion of Spring Street lying between the intersection of Spring and Main Streets and the U. S. Post Office; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that a special election should be held to determine this issue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas:

Section 1. That there be, and is hereby called, a special election to be held on Tuesday, April 26, 1994, at which election there shall be submitted to the electors of the city the question of whether the City should remove parking meters from that portion of Spring Street lying between the intersection of Spring and Main Streets and the U. S. Post Office.

Section 2. Inasmuch as a special election is being held on April 26, 1994, and the city is desirous of placing additional measures on that ballot, time is of the essence and an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from the date of its passage and approval.
