

## ORDINANCE NO. 1585

### AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 8, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Eureka Springs has determined that Chapter 8.16, Parking, and Chapter 8.28, One-way Streets, of the Municipal Code should be amended in order to facilitate the orderly flow of traffic in Eureka Springs;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS, THAT:**

#### **Section One: Amendment To Chapter 8.16, Section 8.16.02 Provisions**

The current paragraph regarding one-way traffic on First Street, reference Ordinance No. 949, shall be amended to read: "No parking shall be allowed on the east side of First Street."

#### **Section Two: Amendments to Chapter 8.28, One-way Streets**

1. Section 8.28.01, One-way Vehicular, Pine Street, shall be amended to read: "It shall be unlawful for any vehicle, motorized or unmotorized, to be driven or otherwise operated on Pine Street from the intersection of Pine Street with Prospect Avenue to the intersection of Pine Street with a line extended from the southwest corner of Lot 3, Block 27, to the northwest corner of Lot 3, Block 29, all as shown on the Riley and Armstrong Plat of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, in any direction other than an easterly direction or a southeasterly direction (downhill). Any person violating this Chapter shall, upon conviction thereof in the Municipal Court of Eureka Springs, be deemed guilty of a Class "C" Misdemeanor and shall be fined a sum not exceeding One Hundred Dollars (\$100) nor less than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25)."

2. Section 8.28.02, One-way Vehicular, Mountain Street, shall be amended to read: "It shall be unlawful for any vehicle, motorized or unmotorized, to be driven or otherwise operated on West Mountain Street from the intersection of West Mountain Street with Spring Street to the intersection of West Mountain Street with Eureka Street, all as shown on the Riley and Armstrong Plat of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, in any direction other than a westerly direction (uphill). Any person violating this Chapter shall, upon conviction thereof in the Municipal Court of Eureka Springs, be deemed guilty of a Class "C" Misdemeanor and shall be fined a sum not exceeding One Hundred Dollars (\$100) nor less than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25)."

#### **Section Three: Repeal Clause**

All Ordinances or Resolutions, and parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

#### **Section Four: Emergency Clause**

The City Council of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, hereby determines and declares that an emergency exists by reason of the need to regulate the flow of traffic and to facilitate the passage of emergency vehicles. The immediate effect of the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents and visitors of the City. This Ordinance, therefore, shall be in full force and effect as of the date of its adoption.
