

ORDINANCE NO. 1596

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING THE REQUIREMENT FOR AN UNDERGROUND DIESEL FUEL STORAGE TANK FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, Title 7, "Public Peace, Safety, and Morals," Chapter 7.24, "Storage and Handling of Gasoline, Naphtha, Benzine, and Other Volatile Combustibles," of the Municipal Code requires: "Any quantity in excess of (5) gallons shall be kept only in a tank or tanks placed not less than two (2) feet beneath the surface of the ground."; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that an above-ground diesel fuel storage tank with a containment basin is appropriate for storing and dispensing diesel fuel at the Public Works Department.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS, THAT:

Section One: Underground Tank Requirement Waived

Pursuant to Title 7, Chapter 7.24, Section 7.24.01, "Restriction on keeping gasoline, naphtha, benzine, and other volatile combustibles," of the Municipal Code, the requirement for an underground diesel fuel storage tank is hereby waived.

Section Two: Repeal Clause

All Ordinances or Resolutions, and parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
