

ORDINANCE NO. 1610

**AN ORDINANCE WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING FOR THE
EMERGENCY PURCHASE OF A POLYMER PUMP FOR THE
WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the polymer pump at the Wastewater Treatment failed on June 3, 1994; and,

WHEREAS, a new polymer pump which is compatible with our existing sludge management system was ordered on June 3rd and installed on June 7th on an emergency basis:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS, THAT:

Section One: Competitive Bidding Requirement Waived

Pursuant to Title 3, Section 3.04.02, Purchases, More Than Five Thousand Dollars, of the Municipal Code, the competitive bidding requirements are hereby waived for the purchase of a Polyblend Pump from Stranco Water Quality Control, Bradley, IL 60915. The purchase price was \$6,500 plus \$279.35 shipping and handling costs.

Section Two: Repeal Clause


All Ordinances or Resolutions, and parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section Three: Emergency Clause


The City Council of the City of Eureka Springs found that this product was not available from any other provider, and the polymer pump is necessary for the Plant's operations and the welfare of the public. Therefore, an emergency is declared; and this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after the date of its publication.
