

ORDINANCE 1651 (AMENDED)

**AN ORDINANCE CREATING A SALARY FOR THE MAYOR OF
THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, has determined that the Mayor should receive some compensation for handling the duties of the Mayor because the Mayor spends a substantial amount of time transacting City business.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, that:

Section One. Chapter 2.28 of the Eureka Springs Municipal Code is amended by the addition of a new section, Section 2.28.05, titled "Salary," which reads as follows:

2.28.05 Salary. Effective January 1, 1996, the person holding the office of Mayor shall be paid an annual salary by the City of Eureka Springs in the amount of \$12,000.

Section Two. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of said conflict.

Section Three. This Ordinance shall be referred to the electors of the City of Eureka Springs in the special election that is to be held within ninety (90) days.

Section Four. Because time is of the utmost importance in coordinating the election dates, an emergency is declared to exist; and this Ordinance is to take effect upon its passage, approval, and publication.
