

ORDINANCE 1652 (AMENDED)

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION FOR THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, has determined that City business requires a substantial amount of time and that each Alderman should receive some compensation for time spent on City business.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, that:

Section One. Chapter 2.24 of the Eureka Springs Municipal Code is amended by the addition of a new section, Section 2.24.04, titled "Compensation," which reads as follows:

2.24.04 Compensation. Effective January 1, 1996, each City Council member shall be paid \$3,000 annually by the City of Eureka Springs as compensation for performing their duties as an Alderman.

Section Two. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of said conflict.

Section Three. This Ordinance shall be referred to the electors of the City of Eureka Springs in the special election that is to be held within ninety (90) days.

Section Four. Because time is of the utmost importance in coordinating the election dates, an emergency is declared to exist; and this Ordinance is to take effect upon its passage, approval, and publication.
