

ORDINANCE NO. 1675

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THREE-WHEELED  
VEHICLES FROM OPERATING OVER CITY STREETS

WHEREAS, A.C.A. 27-49-106 authorizes municipal corporations, with respect to streets and highways under their jurisdiction and within the reasonable exercise of the police power, to regulate or prohibit the traffic from and use of mopeds, three-wheeled vehicles, and other similar vehicles.

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the City to prohibit the traffic from and use of three-wheeled vehicles on the City streets.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS:

Section 1: That Title 8 of the Eureka Springs Municipal Code is amended by the addition of a new chapter, Chapter 8.33, which reads as follows:

Chapter 8.33 Three-Wheeled Vehicles

8.33.01. It shall be unlawful for any person to operate a three-wheeled vehicle (which does not displace in excess of fifty (50) cubic centimeters) over and upon the streets and public ways of the City.

8.33.02. Any person violating the provisions of this Chapter shall be fined not less than Twenty-Five (\$25.00) Dollars nor more than Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars for each violation upon conviction.


Section 2. That Chapter 4.52 of the Eureka Springs Municipal Code is amended by removing therefrom any reference to "three-wheeled vehicles".

Section 3. That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of said conflict.

Section 4. The City Council of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas finds that in order to properly regulate traffic movement over the streets of Eureka Springs and to enforce all ordinances of the City, an emergency is hereby declared to exist.
