

ORDINANCE NUMBER 717


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. That from and after the 1 day of July, 1944, no meter shall be set nor water turned on at any dwelling place within the City of Eureka Springs, without there having first been deposited with the Water Department of said city the sum of \$2.00; nor shall any water be turned on or meter set at any apartment house or hotel with less than 10 rooms unless there has been deposited with the Water Department the sum of \$5.00, and for all hotels, rooming houses and apartment house of more than 10 rooms and for all tourist courts there shall be required a deposit of \$10.00 and for all business houses a deposit of \$3.00.

Section Two: The deposit herein required will be returned to the depositor whenever they have the meter removed, provided they owe no bills for water consumed, and the City Clerk is authorized to deduct from any deposit any amount owed the City for water bill.

Section Three: Whereas many people leave owing water bills and the city has no method of collecting same and a loss results in the water revenues due the city, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect on and after its passage and approval.
