

An Ordinance authorizing conveyance to Rudolph Hintz of part of Lot 1, Block 39, Freeman Addition.

WHEREAS in 1914 J.A. Kuykendall was owner of Lots 1, 3 and 4, Block 39, Freeman Addition to Eureka Springs, and in said year conveyed to said City a strip across said Lot 1 for use in routing Kings highway across said Addition, and erroneously described said Lot 1 instead of said Lot 3, across which last named lot said Street was routed; and the said route over Lot 3 being actually acquired and subjected to said use, and now a part of State Highway 62 through said Addition; and the title of said Kuykendall to all of said lots having passed to the said Rudolph Hintz; NOW,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS:

Section 1. There is hereby granted to Rudolph Hintz, his heirs and assigns all right and claim of the City of Eureka Springs in and to a strip 30 feet wide through Lot 1, Block 39, Freeman Addition, commencing at southeast corner and running direct to the northeast corner; that upon payment of the cost of publication of this Ordinance, the Chairman and Secretary of the City Commission are authorized and directed to execute a quit claim conveyance thereof ~~of the same~~ to the said owner.

Section 2. That this ordinance take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication.
