

ORDINANCE NUMBER 926

WHEREAS, A petition was duly filed with the City Commissioners of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, on the 15th day of August, 1946, asking that the City Commissioners to vacate and abandon all that portion of Sloan Street, in Peebles Addition to the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, lying West of Van Buren Street, designated on the plat of Peebles Addition now appearing of record in the office of the Recorder of Deeds of Carroll County, Arkansas.

Whereas, after due notices as required by law, the commission has, at the time and place mentioned in the notice, heard all persons desiring to be heard on the question and has ascertained that the street or portion thereof, hereinbefore described, has heretofore been dedicated to the Public use as a street herein described; has not been actually used by the public generally for a period of at least five years subsequent to the filing of the plat; that all owners of the property abutting upon the portion of the street to be vacated have filed with the Commission their written consent to such abandonment; and that public interest and welfare will not adversely be affected by the abandonment of such street.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Commission of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas:

Section 1. The City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, hereby releases, vacates and abandons all its rights, together with the rights of the public generally, in and to the street designated as follows:

All that part of Sloan Street, Peebles Addition to the City of Eureka Springs lying West of Van Buren Street.

Section 2. A copy of the ordinance duly certified by the City Clerk shall be filed in the office of the recorder of the county and recorded in the deed records of the county.

Section 3. This ordinance take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
