

ORDINANCE NO. 738

AN ORDINANCE CREATING AN AUDITORIUM COMMISSION TO HAVE CHARGE OF SCRIBING THE MEMBERSHIP OF SAID COMMISSION, TERMS OF OFFICE, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1: There is hereby created a commission, composed of five members whose duties are to have charge of the City Auditorium, regulate its use, to set and collect fees for the use of said building, to supervise the maintenance and up keep of said building.

SECTION 1: Said Commission shall consist of five members, one to be elected by the Parent Teachers Organization; 1 by the Chamber of Commerce; 1 by the Lions Club; 1 by the Rotary Club and one by the Woman's Club. The length of service of each member shall be five years, however at the first meeting of said commission, the members shall determine their length of service by lot, one to serve for one year, one to serve for two years, one to serve for three years, one to serve for four years and one to serve for five years. Annually thereafter the organization whose board member's term shall expire during that year shall elect a successor to serve for five years. Said Commission shall elect one of its members, chairman, another vice chairman, and one as Secretary-Treasurer.

SECTION 3: Said Commission shall have complete charge of the operation of said Auditorium. Grant or reject permits for use of said building, fix the fees to be charged for said use, supervise the maintenance and repairs to said building and to do any and all things necessary for the successful operation of said Auditorium for the use and benefit of the general public.

SECTION 4: If any section, provision or part thereof in this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole, or any part

section or provision thereof, not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 5: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed and it appearing that said building to be used efficiently for civic purposes should have some one in direct control of same and responsible for its maintenance and operation, is such that immediate regulation by a responsible body are necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.
