

An Ordinance to authorize and ratify the conveyance of that part of Joplin Street south of Blocks 48 and 49, and alley between Lots 3 and 4 Block 48, and that part of Paxos Street between Lot 4 Block 48 and Lot 3 Block 49, all in Freeman Addition to City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS:

WHEREAS, By Ordinance No. 456 of November 3, 1908, the City of Eureka Springs found and declared certain streets and alleys therein to be not needed for street or alley purposes, including therein the parts of streets and alleys described in Title hereof; and

WHEREAS, Under date September 17, 1943, the City Commissioners of said city, executed to W. Scott Wilkie and Annette Mary Wilkie a quit claim deed to the same, to-wit: Joplin Avenue between east line of Alamo Street to west line of Lema Street; and that part of Paxos Street between Lot 4 Block 48 and Lot 3 Block 49; and the alley between Lots 3 and 4 Block 48, all in Freeman Addition to said City; NOW

SECTION 1. The City Commission of the City of Eureka Springs, does hereby approve and ratify the aforesaid Quit Claim Deed, as the duly authorized act of the said City, duly executed by Joe A. Morris and Ray Freeman, as City Commissioners thereof.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be retroactive and be in force and effect from and after September 17, 1943.

Ordinance No. 741 an ordinance to ratify and approve a quit claim deed heretofore executed by Commissioners Morris and Freeman to W. Scott Wilkie and Annette Mary Wilkie, conveying parts of Joplin Avenue and parts of Lema Street, and alleys adjacent thereto, was introduced by Commissioner Morris, and was read first time, and rules suspended and read a second time. On motion of Commissioner Freeman that the rules be suspended and the ordinance read a third time, the roll was called and the following Commissioners voted aye: Freeman, Morris, Russell: 3; the following voted nay: none. So the motion prevailed by unanimous vote and the ordinance was read a third time; and on the question: "Shall the Ordinance pass?" the roll was called and the following voted aye: Freeman, Morris, Russell: 3; the following voted nay: None. So the Ordinance passed, and the title thereto agreed to; and was thereupon signed by the City Commissioners.
