Whereas, a petition was duly filed with the City Clerk of the City of Eureka Springs, on the 3rd day of March, 1949, asking the City Commissioners that certain portions of Dickey Street lying between Lots 10-11-12, Block 89 and Lots 10-11-12, Block 90 R&A Survey, starting with the south boundary of Lots 12 and ending with the North boundary of Lots 10, be abandoned, and,

Whereas, after the publication of notice two weeks in the Times Echo, a weekly newspaper of bona fide and general circulation in Eureka Springs which was published in the way, time and manner provided by law and the proof of publication being filed herein and this being the date set by the City Commissioners to hear said petition, and no one appearing in opposition to the same and it being ascertained that the petitioner herein has in all respects complied with the law, and that said ~~portion~~ of lots have not been used by the public at any time subsequent to the filing of the petition and plat herein, and that there are no intersected parties having property abutting upon that portion of street to be vacated and the public interests and welfare will not be adversely affected by the abandonment of said lots.

Now, therefore, be it ordained by the City Commission of the City of Eureka Springs, Carroll County, Arkansas,

Section 1: The City of Eureka Springs in the State of Arkansas, hereby releases, vacates and abandons all rights together with all the interests of the public generally in and to the following described alley, to wit:

~~All that portion of alley lying and being between--~~

All that portion of Dickey Street lying between Lots 10-11-12, Block 89 and Lots 10-11-12, Block 90 R&A Survey, starting with the south boundary of Lots 12 and ending with the North boundary of Lots 10.

Section 2: A copy of this Ordinance duly certified by the City Clerk shall be filed with the recorder of deeds of Carroll County, Arkansas, and recorded in Deed Records and the Mayor and the City Clerk on behalf of and for the City of Eureka Springs is hereby authorized and directed to execute a deed conveying the aforesaid property to the said O. A. Sabom or this Ordinance may be considered as a deed and conveyance of said property aforesaid.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage.
