

ORDINANCE NUMBER 358

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING TO JAMES HERVEY <sup>+ wife</sup> A 99 YEAR LEASE ON A PORTION OF BUTZ STREET:

Be it ordained by the City Commissioners of the City of Eureka Springs,

Whereas, a petition was duly filed with the City Clerk by James Hervey asking that the City Commissioners grant him a lease for a period of 99 years on that portion of Butz Street lying and being between Lots 1 and 2, Block 65, west side of Butz Street, and Lot 16, Block 64, east side of Butz Street, <sup>R & A Survey</sup> and

Whereas, said portion of Butz Street is not needed for public purposes and said petitioner agrees to keep said street clean and weeds cut, a notice was published in the Times Echo, a newspaper of general circulation in Eureka Springs, in the way, time and manner provided by law and the proof of publication being filed herein, and this being the date set by law and no one appearing in opposition to same;

Now, therefore, be it ordained that James Hervey <sup>+ wife</sup> be granted a 99 year lease to said property, <sup>+ the Mayor of the City of E. S. is hereby ordered to execute said lease</sup>

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval. Passed and approved this 20th day of November, 1950.
