

ORDINANCE NUMBER 762

AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ELIMINATING THE TRAVEL OF TRUCKS ON CERTAIN STREETS IN THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS";

Be it ordained by the City Commissioners of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, that

Whereas, the City of Eureka Springs and certain property owners have gone to considerable expense in the improvement of the following streets: Owen, Elk, Benton, Pine, Mountain and Crescent Grade, and

Whereas, travel upon these streets by truck does considerable damage,

It is therefore ordained by the City Commissioners of the City of Eureka Springs that trucks of one ton or more capacity are hereby prohibited from travel on the above named streets, provided however, that in cases of necessity, permits may be obtained from the Chief of Police for trucks to use said street.

Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and fined in a sum not less than one dollar nor more than fifty dollars.

It is hereby declared that an emergency exists and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.
