

ORDINANCE NO. 763

Whereas, a petition was duly filed with the City Clerk of the City of Eureka Springs, ^{by Mrs. Gertrude Nichols} Asking the City Commissioners to abandon that portion of an alley lying and being between the east half of Lots 3, Block 11 and Lot 4, Block 11, Freeman's Addition, and that said alley or portion thereof be conveyed to petitioner.

Whereas, after the publication of notice in the Times Echo, a weekly newspaper of bona fide and general circulation in Eureka Springs, and the proof of publication being filed herein, and this being the date set by the City Commissioners to hear said petition, no one appearing against same, and it being ascertained that the petitioner herein has in all respects complied with the law:

Now, therefore be it ordained by the City Commissioners of the City of Eureka Springs, Carroll County, Arkansas:

Section 1: The City of Eureka Springs, in the State of Arkansas, hereby releases, vacates and abandons all its rights together with all the interest of the general public in and to the following described alley: *Alley lying between E. 1/2 of Lots 3, Block 11 + Lot 4, Block 11*

Section 2: ~~The Mayor and the City Clerk on behalf of and for the City of Eureka Springs is hereby authorized and directed to execute a deed conveying the aforesaid property to the said Mrs. Gertrude Nichols.~~
the petitioner herein.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage. Approved this 4th day of September, 1951.
