

Ordinance 767

ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE PLAYING OF MUSIC MACHINES AND/OR JUKE BOXES IN THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS:

Be it ordained by the City Commissioners of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas:

Section 1 - Whereas, the loud playing of music machines, radios, and juke boxes tend to disturb the peace of the citizens of Eureka Springs, and  
Whereas, there have been installed at several places outside amplifiers or speakers that increase said disturbance,

Section 2 - On and after the effective date of this Ordinance, it shall be unlawful for any person to play such above described machines in such manner as to and does disturb the peace of any resident of said City after the hour of 12:00 midnight up to and including the hour of 8:00 a.m., and it shall further be unlawful for any person to connect with said machines any amplifier or loud speaker, without first having obtained the permission of the Chief of Police to do so.

Section 3 - Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and be fined in any amount not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$50.00, and since the playing of said machines has in the past tended to disturb the peace of the citizens of Eureka Springs, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
