

Ordinance 769

AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE ~~PRIVILEGE~~ OF
DOING GUIDE SERVICE IN THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS.

Be it Enacted by the City Commissioners of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas:

Section 1 - That it shall be unlawful for any person to drum or solicit strangers, visitors or other persons, or who shall engage in the business of drumming or soliciting strangers, visitors or other persons to offer their services as guides in and about the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, without first having obtained a license therefor, as hereinafter provided.

Section 2 - That any person who shall desire to drum or solicit strangers, visitors or other persons, to engage their services as guides are hereby required to be of reputable character and shall make application to the City Clerk for such license; and pay to the City Treasurer the sum of \$10.00 per annum in advance, said sum to be considered a reasonable amount for issuing a license, keeping record of same and all police and other lawful regulations incident thereto, and connected with such business, and shall take his receipt for same and file with the City Clerk.

Section 3 - The words business or drumming, soliciting as used herein shall be considered to mean any word, deed or act whereby one person shall endeavor, to induce, influence or prevail upon any other person as a guide.

Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined \$5.00 and \$10.00 for each repetition of the offense or violation.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval and publication.
