

ORDINANCE #772

AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE KEEPING OF CATTLE, SWINE, HORSES, SHEEP AND GOATS INSIDE THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS:

Be It Ordained by the City Commissioners of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas:

Section 1: Whereas the keeping of cattle, swine, horses, sheep and goats within the City Limits of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, creates a hazard for the peace, health and safety of the citizens of said City,

Section 2: It shall be unlawful for any persons to keep within the City Limits of said City any swine, cattle, horses, sheep or goats and any person violating any of the provisions of the Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not less than \$5.00 or more than \$100.00 for the first offense and for each succeeding offense thereafter in a sum not more than \$250.00 and each day in which said Ordinance is violated shall be deemed a separate offense.

Whereas, the keeping of said cattle, swine, horses, sheep and goats within the corporate limits is detrimental to the peace, health and safety of the citizens, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication. All laws or parts of laws in conflict with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are repealed.
