

ORDINANCE NO. 781

AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED AN ORDINANCE VACATING CERTAIN STREETS IN THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS.

SECTION 1. Whereas, the Bullock Manufacturing Company has filed with the City Commission of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, a petition asking that the hereinafter described street be abandoned and leased to them as being no longer needed for street purposes; and

WHEREAS, in pursuance to said petition the City Commission did give notice of a hearing upon said petition, to be held at the City Hall on February 1, 1954 at 4:00 o'clock P. M., proof of publication of said notice having been returned and duly filed, and

WHEREAS, on said 1st day of February 1954 this matter came on to be heard by said Commission, and

WHEREAS, no one appeared in opposition to said petition.

Upon motion duly made and passed the City of Eureka Springs did grant said petition and ordered the following street closed:

All that part of Kansas Street lying and being between Blocks 42 and 43 Clayton, and Lots 13, 14 and 15 Block 24 Riley.

Now, therefore, be it ordained that the Bullock Manufacturing Company be granted a 99 year lease to said property and the Mayor of the City of Eureka Springs is hereby ordered to execute said lease.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval. Passed and approved this 1st day of February 1954.
