

ORDINANCE NUMBER.....796.....

AND ORDINANCE ENTITLED, AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC HAZARDS:

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS.

SECTION 1. Whereas the placing of commercial signs at the intersection of Kings Highway and West Benton Street ^{and Midway Avenue} in the city of Eureka Springs, Arkansas has created an unnecessary traffic hazard at said intersection, and said intersection being also located at the Public Schools, said signs create an additional pedestrian traffic problem.

Section 2. In order to eliminate said traffic hazard it is hereby ordered that all commercial signs now located at or adjacent to the School grounds and in the vicinity of the junction of Kings Highway and West Benton Street and Midway Avenue, in the city of Eureka Springs, be removed within 10 days after the passage, approval and publication of this ordinance, and it is further ordained that no person~~s~~ or persons shall erect or place any commercial signs at said intersections after the effective date of this ordinance, and that if said signs are not removed within 10 days after the passage, approval and publication of this ordinance that the chief of police of said city is ordered to take down all commercial signs at said location.

Section 3. Any person~~s~~ or persons violating this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fine in a sum not exceeding \$25.00 for each offense against same.

Section 4. This ordinance being necessary for the peace, health and safety of the citizens of Eureka Springs, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage, approval and publication.
