

ORDINANCE NO. 808

An Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance authorizing leasing a part of Spring Street, in the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, to Otto Bergman and Rene Bergman."

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, THAT,

WHEREAS, the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, by its City Commissioners, gave notice on the 6th day of October 1960 that they were considering the matter of leasing a certain portion of Spring Street in the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, described as follows to-wit:

That part of Spring Street adjacent to and adjoining to land on the North 29 feet of Lot 7 front and back and part of Lot 8 front and back, Block 5, Riley and Armstrong Plat, and.

WHEREAS, said notice was duly published in the way, time and manner provided by law, in the Eureka Springs Times-Echo, proof of publication having been filed with the City Clerk and that in said notice it was stated that a hearing upon said matter would be held at the next regular meeting of the City Commissioners at the City Hall, City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, and calling on all persons to appear and show cause if any why the City should not lease said portion of said street as set out.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDAINED that the Mayor and City Clerk proceed at once to execute said lease as herein above provided for.

This ordinance being necessary for the peace, health and safety of the citizens of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, a state of emergency is hereby declared and said Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and approval.
