

ORDINANCE # 810

WHEREAS an old and abandoned cemetery within the city limits in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ being all that part of said forty lying north of the U.S. Highway #62 and east of the East Mountain Road, which is now owned by Joyce Davis Harvey, AND

WHEREAS said cemetery or burial ground has not been used since the early 1880's, now notice is hereby given requiring all persons having dead buried therein to cause the same to be removed within thirty (30) days and buried beyond the limits of the city, and in the event such bodies are not removed within the said time, the said Joyce Davis Harvey is hereby authorized to remove such bodies as can be found and bury them in another cemetery. AND, upon the said bodies being removed, said Joyce Davis Harvey shall be entitled to a deed ^{from City} for what is described as a 200 x 200 foot tract of land known as an old cemetery, in said lands aforesaid.

AND, upon removal of such bodies as may be found, said cemetery is vacated as a burial ground and hereby declared no longer a cemetery. Thereafter said land shall be subject to taxation.
