

AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:

"AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, COUNTY OF CARROLL, STATE OF ARKANSAS AMENDING ORDINANCE 569, WHICH WAS PASSED ON MAY 7, 1917 AND NOW APPEARS AS SECTION 361 OF THE EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS, CODE OF 1940. THE PURPOSE AND INTENTION OF THIS ORDINANCE IS TO FURTHER CONTROL AND REGULATE THE KEEPING OF DOGS WITHIN THE LIMITS OF SAID CITY."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS THAT ORDINANCE #569, WHICH WAS PASSED ON MAY 7, 1917 AND NOW APPEARS AS SECTION 361 OF THE EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS, CODE OF 1940 BE AND THE SAME IS HEREBY AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. All dogs kept in the city shall be registered as to sex, breed, name of dog and the name and address of the owner of dog. At the time of such registration such owner or person in custody shall obtain a license for such dog and shall pay a fee of two dollars (\$2.00) for each dog.

SECTION Ia. It shall be the duty of the owner or person in custody of any dog kept in the city to have the dog inoculated against rabies at least once each year. No license for a dog shall be issued unless the applicant exhibits a certificate by a veterinarian showing compliance with this section within one year prior to the issuance of the license.

SECTION II. That all Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed and this action being necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the date of its passage.
