

ORDINANCE NO. 856

AN ORDINANCE EXEMPTING EXISTING LIVESTOCK AUCTION BARN
IN AN AREA TO BE ANNEXED TO THE CITY FROM THE PROVISIONS OF
ORDINANCE NO. 772.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF
EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS, TOWIT:

WHEREAS, certain persons have heretofore filed a petition with the Carroll
County Judge, requesting that certain property referred to as " THE STADIUM
ADDITION TO THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS " be annexed to
the City Limits of the said City, and that included in said property requested
to be annexed is the property on which is located the Eureka Sales Company;
and,

That it is the opinion of this Commission that it would be to the best advan-
tage of the City for the said Auction to continue to operate, and as it is now
operated it is not a nuisance or public health hazard; and,

That the provisions of Ordinance No. 772 prohibit the keeping of certain
livestock within the city limits of said city;

NOW THEREFORE, the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, by and through
its duly elected and qualified City Commission, does hereby exempt that property
on which is located the Eureka Sales Company from the provisions and penalties
of Ordinance No. 772, and it shall so remain exempt until a court of competent
jurisdiction shall determine that same has become a nuisance.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its
approval as required by law.
