

AN ORDINANCE CALLING A SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION  
IN THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS.

WHEREAS, a vacancy has occurred in the Board of Commissioners of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas by the resignation of Jan M. Bullock, and whereas more than six months remains of the term to which he was elected, and under law, a special election must be called to fill said vacancy; now, therefore, BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas:

SECTION 1. That a special municipal election be held on the 30 day of Jan 1968 in the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, for the purpose of electing one City Commissioner to fill the unexpired term of Jan M. Bullock.

SECTION 2. That said election shall be held under and pursuant to Act 305 of 1915 as amended by Act 439 of 1917 as enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Arkansas and other applicable general Statutes of the State of Arkansas pertaining to special elections; that the Mayor of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas is hereby authorized to issue and publish a proclamation calling said election.

SECTION 3. That candidates for said offices to be voted upon on said date must file their qualifying petitions not later than twenty (20) days before Jan. 30 1968, with the City Clerk and the Secretary of the Board of Election Commissioners for Carroll County, Arkansas.

SECTION 4. That a certified copy of this Ordinance and the Mayor's proclamation be given to the Election Commissioners of Carroll County, Arkansas, in order that they may prepare the ballots and provide for the officials to conduct the election and that a certified copy be given to the Sheriff in order that he may issue his proclamation of the special election.

SECTION 5. That it is hereby ascertained that there is an immediate need to fill said vacancy in the City Commission of Eureka Springs, Arkansas; therefore an emergency exists and this Ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public and general welfare, and shall take effect and be in force without delay from after its passage.
