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ORDINANCE NO. 904

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION I OF ORDINANCE NO. 829, ESTABLISHING THE RATES FOR WATER SERVICES TO BE FURNISHED BY THE MUNICIPAL WATER WORKS SYSTEM OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City Council of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, has determined that the rates for water services to be furnished by the Municipal Water Works System of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, as established in Section I of Ordinance No. ⁸²⁹⁺⁹⁰⁴ ~~829~~, passed and approved on January 24, 1963, are not sufficient to both properly operate the Municipal Water Works System and retire the bonded indebtedness on said water works system;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS:

SECTION I: That Section I of Ordinance No. 829, as passed by the City Commissioners of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, on January 24, 1963, is hereby amended to read as follows: The monthly rates for water services shall be as follows:

First 2,000 gallons, \$3.00 (minimum)	3.00	}	8.60
Next 8,000 gallons, 70¢ per 1,000 gallons	5.60		
Next 20,000 gallons, 60¢ per 1,000 gallons	12.00		
Next 70,000 gallons, 50¢ per 1,000 gallons	35.00		55.60
Next 100,000 gallons, 40¢ per 1,000 gallons			
Over 200,000 gallons, 30¢ per 1,000 gallons			

All water consumers shall be on meter service. Bills shall be rendered monthly, and if not paid within ten days from date of rendition a penalty of ten per cent (10%) of the amount of the bill shall be added, and if not paid within thirty days, services will be discontinued. Service shall be restored upon payment of all delinquent charges and penalties and a \$2.50 reconnection charge.

SECTION 2: It is hereby ascertained and declared that there is an immediate need, to increase the rates for water services as furnished by the Municipal Water Works System in order to both maintain said water works system and to retire the bonded indebtedness and thus protect the health and property of the inhabitants of the City

of Eureka Springs, Arkansas; therefore, an emergency exists and this ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall take affect and be in force without delay from and after its passage.
