

ORDINANCE No. 911

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING A TAX ON ALL REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY IN THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City ^{Council} ~~Commissioners~~ of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas:

SECTION I: That a tax of fourteen (14) mills on the dollar is hereby levied on all real and personal property within the corporate limits of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, as follows:

- 1. General purposes of Ordinary fund - 5 mills.
- 2. Hospital Bond Fund - 5 mills.
- 3. Firemen's Relief & Pension Fund - 1 mill.
- 4. Voluntary mills, Fire Department - 2½ mills.
- 5. Voluntary mills, Municipal Library - ½ mill.

SECTION II: That the fourteen (14) mills are to be levied and collected at the regular collection of taxes by the Collector of Carroll County, Arkansas, at the same time and in the same manner that State and County Taxes are collected in the year 1970.

SECTION III: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.


