

ORDINANCE NO. 920

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 406 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS; ESTABLISHING ADDITIONAL NO PARKING ZONES ON SPRING STREET AND/OR THE BOULEVARD IN THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS, THAT

SECTION I. That Section 406 of the Code of Ordinances for the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, is hereby amended to establish the following additional No Parking Zones on Spring Street and/or The Boulevard in the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, to-wit:

It shall be unlawful for any automobile, truck or other vehicle to be parked within the following designated areas on Spring Street and/or The Boulevard in the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas: On the West side of Spring Street between the junctions of German Alley and Tulip Street; on the East side of Spring Street from the junction of Tulip Street to the Crescent Spring; on the West side of Spring Street and/or The Boulevard from the Presbyterian Church to the junction of King Street; on the East side of Spring Street and/or The Boulevard from the junction of King Street to the junction of Crescent Avenue; on the West side of Spring Street and/or The Boulevard from junction of Crescent Avenue to the East edge of the Grotto Spring Reservation.

SECTION II. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION III. This ordinance being necessary for the immediate control and regulation of traffic on Spring Street and/or The Boulevard in the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, and this ordinance being further necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, an emergency is hereby declared and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and approval.
