

ORDINANCE NO. 921

AN ORDINANCE COMBINING THE OFFICES OF CITY RECORDER AND CITY TREASURER AND PROVIDING FOR THE ELECTION OF A RECORDER-TREASURER AT THE NEXT GENERAL ELECTION.

WHEREAS, Ark. Stat. Ann. §1103.1 (Repl. 1968) allows a City of the Second Class, upon passage of an ordinance to combine the offices of City Recorder and City Clerk.

AND WHEREAS, the City Council of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, deems it in the best interest of the City to so combine said offices.

NOW THEREFORE:

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas,

SECTION I: That on January 1, 1971, the office of Recorder and office of City Treasurer in the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, shall be combined into one office, which office shall be known as "Recorder-Treasurer" for the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, and held by one person.

SECTION II: That the present duly elected City Recorder and City Treasurer shall continue in office until the expiration of their respective terms or December 31, 1970.

SECTION III: That the qualified voters of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, shall at the next general election, elect one person as Recorder-Treasurer for a term of two years.

SECTION IV: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION V: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the passage, approval and publication.
