

ORDINANCE NO. 927

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 786; DESIGNATING AND ESTABLISHING ADDITIONAL PARKING METER ZONES.

WHEREAS Ordinance No. 786 passed and approved by the City Commission of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, on February 14, 1955, established certain parking meter zones, and

WHEREAS on the 1st day of June, 1971, the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, leased the parking lot commonly known as the "Courthouse Parking Lot" from Carroll County, Arkansas, now

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1: That Section Five of Ordinance No. 786 is hereby amended to include the "Courthouse Parking Lot" as an additional parking meter zone; that said "Courthouse Parking Lot" is more particularly described as follows:

Front & Back Lots 13, 14, 15, 17, 18 and Front & Back Lot 16, Less & Except that portion of said lot on which the Western District Courthouse is located, all in Block 156, R & A Survey to the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas. That no parking meters shall be placed on parking spaces immediately adjoining the Courthouse on the South side as same shall be reserved for the use of the County or those persons having Courthouse business.

SECTION 2: Any person desiring to park any vehicle within a parking meter space on the "Courthouse Parking Lot" shall deposit the proper coins for the time desired as follows:

One nickle for one (1) hour;
One dime for two (2) hours;
One quarter for five (5) hours.
