

ORDINANCE NO. 935

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A HOSPITAL COMMISSION PURSUANT TO ARKANSAS ACT 322 OF 1947, AS AMENDED; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. Hospital Commission created. There is hereby created a Hospital Commission of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, pursuant to the authority and provisions of Arkansas Act 322 of 1947, as amended.

SECTION 2. Emergency clause. That in the judgment of the City Council of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, the public peace, health and safety of the City and the inhabitants thereof demand the immediate passage of this Ordinance, and the public peace is endangered, an emergency is hereby declared to exist whereby this Ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
