

ORDINANCE NO. 946

AN ORDINANCE ABOLISHING THE POSITION OF CITY MARSHALL IN THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS, AND ESTABLISHING THE POSITION OF CHIEF OF POLICE FOR THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS: AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Eureka Springs, Arkansas


that:

SECTION I. Abolition and Establishment. The position of City Marshall of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas is hereby abolished, and in replacement thereof the position of Chief of Police of the City of Eureka Springs, Arkansas is hereby created, and the holder of such position shall be entitled to all authority and responsibilities provided by law.

SECTION II. Remuneration. The salary and other allowances payable to the Chief of Police of the City of Eureka Springs shall be in the sums designated by the City Council of Eureka Springs by resolution.

SECTION III. Emergency. It has been found, and is hereby declared, that it is in the best interests of the City of Eureka Springs to alter the mode of administering law enforcement in the City of Eureka Springs, for the preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare of its residents, and an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and so declared, whereby this Ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
