

ORDINANCE NO. 957

AN ORDINANCE TO VEST POWER TO ISSUE LICENSES FOR THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS AND THE CITY COUNCIL, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. Paragraph two of Section 1.1 of Ordinance No. 953 and Ordinance No. 955 are hereby amended to read in their entirety as follows, to-wit:

Said application shall contain a sworn statement of the name of the business sought to be licensed; the names and addresses of all of the persons owning, managing, or holding any interest in said business, and the proposed location of said business; the owner or owners of the building or premises in which said business is to be located; and said applicant's state license shall accompany such application. Then, upon approval by the City Council of Eureka Springs, the City Clerk shall issue such license upon the payment of the license fee provided in this Ordinance and upon compliance with all other requirements of law related to operation of said business. Such permit or license shall be prominently displayed in the location for which that license was issued.

SECTION 2. The first sentence of Section 1.4 of Ordinance 954 as amended to read in its entirety as follows, to-wit:

Upon the approval of said application by the City Council of Eureka Springs, the City Clerk shall issue the applicant a license to sell such beverages as hereinafter described upon the payment by the applicant of the following fees:

(a) Manufacturers: For each manufacturer of beer and light wine located in Eureka Springs, a privilege tax of Two Hundred Fifty (\$250.00) Dollars per year.

(b) Wholesale dealers, brokers, or distributors: For each wholesale dealer, broker, or distributor located in Eureka Springs, a privilege tax of Two Hundred Fifty (\$250.00) Dollars per year.

(c) Retail dealers: For the business of storing, transporting, selling and/or dispensing at retail of any and all beer and light wines having an alcoholic content of not more than five (5%) per cent by weight within the City of Eureka Springs, an annual privilege tax of One Hundred Twenty-Five (\$125.00) Dollars per year for each such retail store operated within the City.

SECTION 3. It has been found, and is hereby declared, that control of sales of alcoholic beverages within the City of Eureka Springs is essential to the development of the City and to the welfare of the inhabitants thereof. This Ordinance, therefore, being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
