

ORDINANCE NO. 984

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCES NO. 786 AND NO. 927
OF THE CITY OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 786 was duly passed by the City Commissioners and approved by the Mayor of the City of Eureka Springs on the 14th day of February, 1955, and published according to law;

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 927 was duly passed by the City Council and approved by the Mayor of the City of Eureka Springs on the 5th day of August, 1971; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Eureka Springs, Arkansas deems it necessary and prudent to decrease, by fifty per centum (50%), the amount of time any vehicle will be lawfully parked for each coin deposited in a parking meter on the "Courthouse Parking Lot."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF EUREKA SPRINGS, ARKANSAS:

That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 927, amending Ordinance No. 786, be and hereby is amended to read, in its entirety, as follows:

SECTION 2:

That any person desiring to park any vehicle within a parking meter space on the "Courthouse Parking Lot" shall deposit the proper coins for the time desired as follows:

One nickel for one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) hour;
One dime for one (1) hour;
One quarter for two and one-half ($2\frac{1}{2}$) hours.
